Why Madison Heights?

Madison Heights, Virginia is a quaint town located just north of Lynchburg City. Separated from Lynchburg by the James River, Madison Heights offers the atmosphere of suburban life just minutes from the city while also providing the uniqueness of a rural community. With over 14,000 people living within a 3 mile radius of Madison Heights, Amherst County is determined to reinforce the area's sense of community while also improving the quality of life for residents. As a goal for the future, the county of Amherst has broken ground on over 1,200 new dwellings, many of which will be part of a town center complex which will bring not only homes but many new businesses to the community of Madison Heights.

With additional growth in the community on the horizon, there is an apparent need for more gospel-centered, disciple-making churches. In a town where over 60% don't attend church, Bedrock Madison Heights desires to engage the community with the hope of the Gospel. We believe God is calling us to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ to the broken, lost, and forgotten.


